1Pet 2:22 "Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: 23 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin."

Isaiah 53:6-9 committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:"
